### ISBF'S EMFSS QUIZ

The EMFSS (Economics, Management, Finance, and Social Sciences) Quiz at ISBF challenged students on topics ranging from economics and business to finance and social sciences. The quiz featured both online and offline formats: Delhi-NCR participants competed onsite at the ISBF campus, while students from other regions joined remotely.

The competition was held in two rounds: the preliminary round and the final round. For students in the Delhi-NCR region, both rounds were conducted offline at the ISBF campus, while participants from outside Delhi-NCR joined the quiz remotely through an online platform.

This hybrid event allowed students to showcase their academic knowledge, engage with peers, and experience ISBF's commitment to fostering intellectual growth and critical thinking.

#### WORKSHOPS

ISBF's Playnomics workshops bring real-world market dynamics into the classroom, helping students apply concepts from Economics, Commerce, and Business Studies to practical scenarios. The Bake Off workshop at Kothari International School, Noida, involved students engaging in a business simulation where they managed bakery units, negotiated resources, and formulated strategies to maximize revenue. The session highlighted concepts like consumer behavior, international trade, and marketing. At DRS International School and Gitanjali Senior School in Hyderabad, the 'Win-Win' workshop simulated international trade, where students exchanged resources to generate maximum profits. Both workshops emphasized teamwork, negotiation, and strategic decision-making, and concluded with a discussion on ISBF's courses and career opportunities.
