## **Scholarships & Financial Aid**

### **Academic Session 2018-2021**

Three kinds of scholarships are available for ISBF students, the details of which are given below. The number of awards for each scholarship is limited.

#### **1. ISBF Scholarship**

This scholarship is available at the time of admission, i.e. for the first year of study at ISBF. It comprises a waiver of up to 50 percent of the ISBF tuition fee. It is awarded on the basis of merit, measured by the applicant's performance in the ISBF Entrance Test and Personal Interview, as well as financial need. This award continues in the second and third years of study, subject to the awardee maintaining a stipulated level of academic performance at ISBF.

To be eligible to apply for the ISBF Scholarship 2018, you should be completing / have completed Class 12 in 2018. You should also have completed the ISBF admission process, i.e. the application form, the Entrance Test and the Personal Interview.

#### **2. University of London Achievement Awards**

These scholarships are awarded by University of London every year, to students of the University of London International Programmes in the Indian subcontinent. They comprise waivers of up to 100 percent of University of London's tuition fees in the second year of study. The merit for these awards is determined on the basis of a student's performance in the LSE examinations at the end of the first year of study at ISBF.

As a result, these awards are only available to continuing ISBF students (i.e. they are not available at the time of admission). There is no application process for these awards; they are directly notified and awarded by the University of London.

#### **3. LSE Summer School Scholarships**

These scholarships are awarded to two ISBF students every year, and cover in full the costs of attending a 3-week LSE Summer School programme, in London, with students from around the world. The merit for these awards is determined on the basis of a student's academic performance at ISBF (internal assessments as well as the year-end LSE examinations) as well as other contributions to college life at ISBF.

As a result, these awards are only available to continuing ISBF students, i.e. students who have completed their first or second years of study. The application process for these awards is notified to ISBF students in the course of the academic session.
